



Checklist recordbooks

Update 04.2018

- Fill in the date of “starting the Award”.
- Indicate the name and address in block letters (do not forget the postcode).
- Fill in the name of the Award Leader.
- Date started: the activity should be considered from the moment the participant registered for the Award.
- Date completed: “ongoing” -> not accepted; fill in a date (it is necessary to keep a clear overview if the participant starts the next level).
- Horse-riding is not a skill but a sport.
- Family members are not allowed to sign for an activity .
- The expedition section must be supervised by a person certified by the *Mérite Jeunesse*.
- Student concerts don't count for the volunteer section, except if they really play a whole concert and not just one piece of music.
- No sport activity counts as a skill.
- Yoga/Pilates is not a skill but a sport.
- Dancing (also ballet) is a sport and does not count as a skill.
- A residential project should not be undertaken with peers. They can go to a place together, but have to work in different groups with people who are not their usual companions.
- An activity must be signed off in the RB, no carnets or papers.
